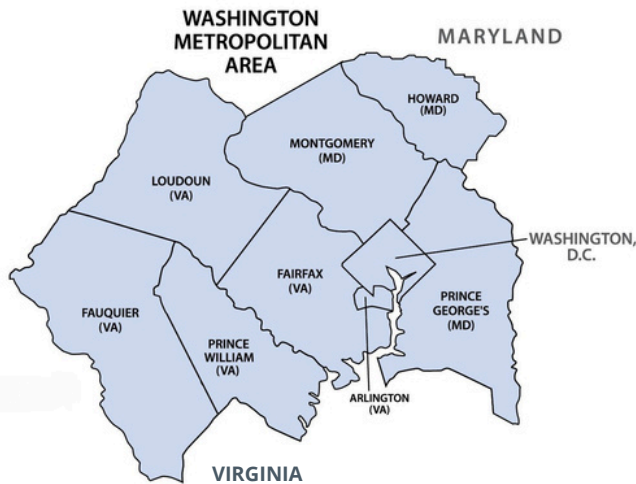


Where We Serve
